any of my stock left at the death of my  
wife that my son William shall have, -  
Lastly I do appoint, Edmund Duffey, Fran-  
cis Vaughan & Robert Anglen Executors to  
this my last will and testament. In wit-  
ness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and seal this 10<sup>th</sup> day of November day  
of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred  
and one.
